Take I-75 south to St. Rt. 274, go west through New Bremen to St. Johns Rd., go south about 1.5 miles. Center is on the west side of the road.

From the South:

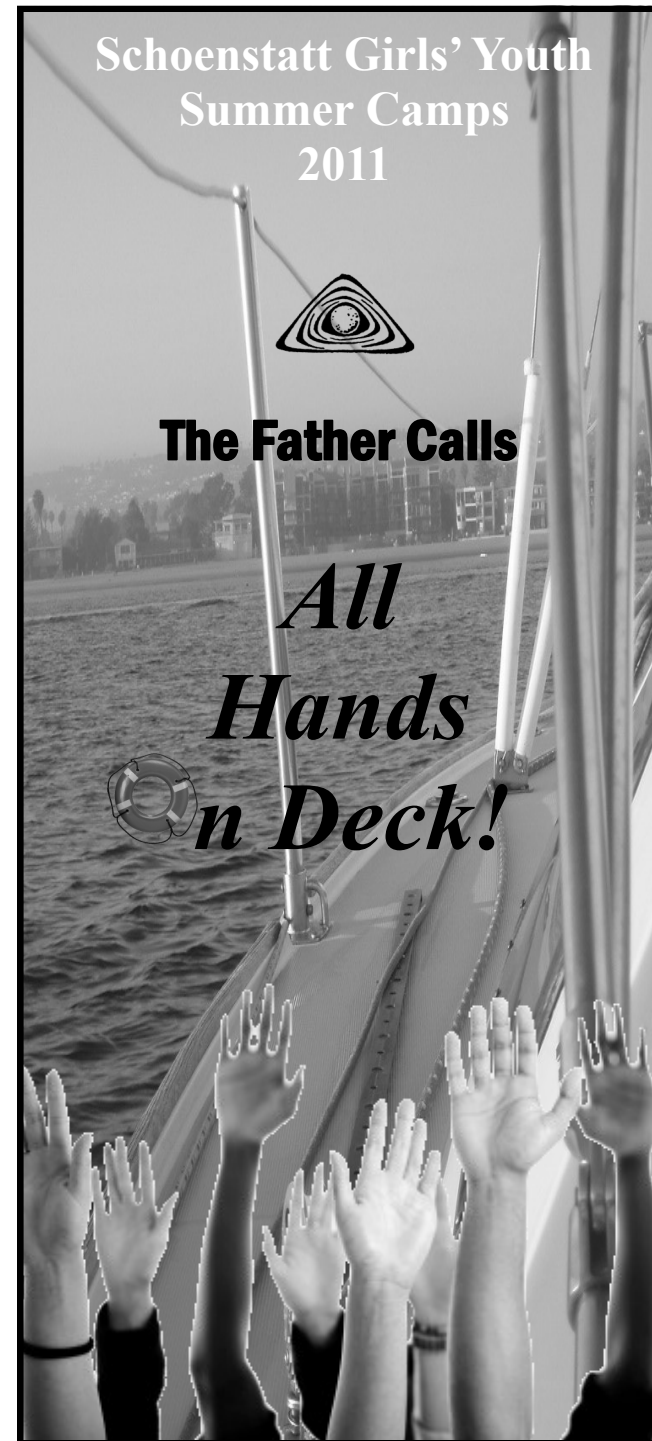
Take I-75 North to St. Rt. 119, go west through Minster. Follow Rt. 119 into Maria Stein and turn north on St. Johns Rd. Go approximately .5 mile, Center is on the west side of the road.

From the East:

Take US 33 northwest to St. Rt. 274, go through New Bremen to St. Johns Rd. Turn south and go about 1.5 miles. Center is on the west side of the road.

From the West:

Take I-70 East to St. Rt. 127, go North to St. Rt. 119. Turn east and follow 119 into Maria Stein. Turn north on St. Johns Rd. Go approximately .5 mile and the Center is on the west side of the road.

Cost:

The Day camp costs \$ 10.00.
The overnight camp fee is \$ 49.00; for moms
who want to join us the cost is \$ 65.00.
A non-refundable deposit of \$5.00 must ac-
company the registration form. The balance is
to be paid upon arrival.

Time:

The Day Camp on August 3, begins at 9:30
and ends at 3:00 p.m.
The Overnight Camp begins on Aug 4th at
1:00 pm. (Please inform us if you need to
